### 1. Chandler House 53 Church Street

#### *The Magic Cat*

The Voorkamer Gallery at Chandler House is delighted to be hosting Chloe Townsend's debut exhibition. Townsend is a well-known Cape Town creative, admired and respected for her luxury leather goods studio Missibaba.

*The Magic Cat* which marks the transition from maker/designer to artist. The works on the show are a distillation of her bold, colourful aesthetic as well as a step towards a new vocabulary; that includes still life, interior scenes, lush botanical themes and the surreal.

### 4. Speakers Corner at Church Square Corner of Spin and Parliament Streets

#### *The Light Tank*

Take a stroll through the freshly regenerated Church Square whilst enjoying a super cool, techy installation by the local genius' from Polycat Visual Effects.

The LightLank is a technological display of art created using their expertise in 3D animation. Get dazzled by a multi-sensory experience centred around a giant cube of 25 000 led lights that with breathtaking visuals synced delicately to symphonic electronic music.

### 5. Studio 3 3 Wandel Street, Dunkley Square

#### *Genius Loci - A Sense of Place*

A unique opportunity to see an exhibition hosted in the artist's studio and workplace. Gwen Van Embden's new body of work, *Genius Loci*, work deals with notions of identity, place and space.

In classical mythology, the Latin term *Genius Loci* refers to a protective spirit attached to a place - a guardian who watches over their part of the world and imbues it with a special character. In modern reality, we still need to be able to identify a genius loci in order to give us an understanding of our environment.

The presence of the artist is felt by keeping focus on the working process and in the transformation of the space into a continuous work in progress, devoid of finality, like art, it pulsates via the pure movement of the spirit
